

PAINT RECYCLING

Paints and products that are accepted

- Primers and paints (water or solvent based, enamel, etc.)
- Paints for metals and anti-corrosive paints
- Aluminum paints, Melamine paints
- Interior and exterior stains
- Wood finishes and masonry protectors
- Varnishes, Shellacs
- Pool paints
- Marine paints without antifouling agent
- Oil protective finishes
- Aerosol paints and containers (general purpose, industrial, automobile, artist paint, lumber marking)
- Empty cans

Paints and products that are not accepted

- Primers and paints intended for industrial use (used by professionals, in manufacturing process, inside plants or paint workshops such as car dealers, bodyshops and garages except aerosol paints)
- Traffic paints
- Dryfall paints
- Automotive paints (except aerosol paints)
- Removers, thinners and diluents
- Two-component paints and coatings
- Artist paints (all types of art paints except aerosol paints)
- Antifouling paints
- Wood préservatives containing pesticides
- Grouts, plasters, cement, patching compounds, plastic wood and cladding products (ex. stucco)
- Adhesives and glue
- Roofing products or Founding coatings, crackfillers and asphalt-based and coal tar sealers
- Cleaners and polishes (ex. : deck cleaner, lemon oil)
- All products not in their original containers or without label
- Paint in glass containers

Sizes of containers that are accepted

100 ml size containers and over (sold by retailers). 50 L size containers and less (sold by wholesalers) ** All products must be returned in their original containers.



OIL RECYCLING

- used oils
- used glycol (antifreeze)
- used oil and glycol (antifreeze) containers of 50 liters or less (including aerosol break cleaner and lubricant)



LIGHT RECYCLING

- Compact Fluorescent Light (CFL)
- Fluorescent Tubes (straight, linear, circular, or curved)
- High Intensity Discharge (HID)
- UV & Germicidal
- Ultra High Performance (UHP) with Mercury Arc



BATTERY RECYCLING

- Nickel-Cadmium (commonly found in cordless power tools, cordless phones, digital cameras, video cameras, two-way radios)
- Nickel-metal hydride (commonly found in cell phones, cordless power tools, cordless phones, digital cameras, two-way radios)
- Lithium-Ion (commonly found in cordless power tools, digital cameras, laptop computers, cell phones)
- Small Sealed Lead-Acid Batteries (commonly found in mobility scooters, fire emergency devices, emergency exit signs, UPS back-up batteries)
- Alkaline (commonly found in alarm clocks, calculators, flashlights, TV remotes, toy remotes)
- Lithium primary (commonly found in keyless car entry remotes, watches, pacemakers)
