SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Reporting to the Chief Mine Geologist, the Senior Geologist plans, supervises and carries out all work for the geological monitoring of excavation work. He is responsible for:

- Supervise and carry out all work that must lead to the reinterpretation of mineralized zones;
- Assist his supervisor in all of the Company's operating activities;
- Supervise the work of the Geological Technicians, responsible for controlling the content in the pits, on the ROMPAD and in the underground mine;
- Assist in the planning of the definition drilling work;
- Carry out the implementation and monitoring of drilling work and the description of the definition drill cores;
- Conduct geological mapping and targeted sampling;
- Supervise the processing, integration and interpretation of drilling data;
- Work on different mining sites;
- Perform preliminary compilations and interpretations of drilling and field data;
- Perform any other tasks that the Chief Geologist may deem necessary to ensure the efficient conduct and quality of exploration activities.

REQUIREMENTS

- University degree (BAC) in geosciences (geology or geological engineering);
- The Geologist must be a member in good standing of the *Ordre des géologues* or *des Ingénieurs du Québec*
- Good knowledge of the geological and structural phenomena of rock bases;
- A minimum of 5 to 7 years of experience in mining geology from pit and underground operations;
- Good knowledge of Microsoft Suite, GEMS and Promine software;
- Bilingualism (French and English);
- Ability to communicate verbally and in writing (emails, reports, presentations, etc.);
- Training on Mining Modules (FMTM), an asset;
